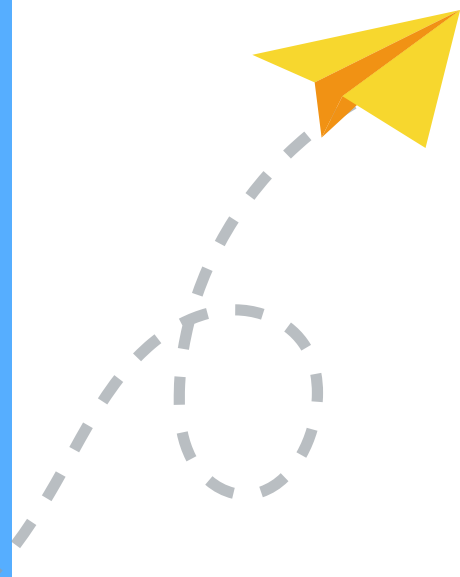

## FAMILY ACTIVITIES TO PROMOTE CIVIC LEADERSHIP IN CHILDREN



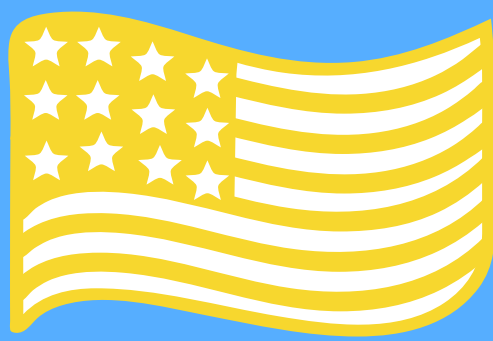
Look for a community project that interests your child and volunteer for a day.

Sing patriotic songs and practice the Pledge of Allegiance.

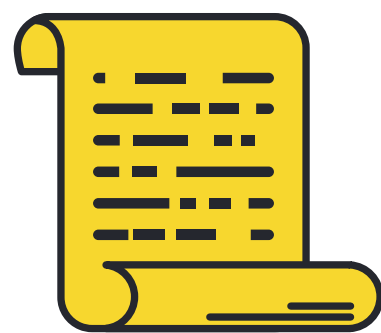
Read a biography about a famous leader.
